SEMI PERMANENT MAKEUP

PRE TREATMENT INFORMATION

Consultation

When you come for your consultation, try and wear your makeup as you normally would apply it, so your permanent makeup specialist has an idea of how you like to wear it and the effect you would like to achieve.

Eyebrows

Do not wax/pluck for 5 days prior to treatment, your permanent makeup specialist will shape your brows during the treatment.

Eyeliner

Eyes may water during this treatment, this is quite normal contact lens wearers will need to remove the lenses prior to treatment, you will be able to re apply them after the treatment but may wish to bring glasses with you. eyes may be sensitive to light after a treatment and being closed for a period of time, you may wish to bring sunglasses for your journey home, to avoid rubbing your eyes.

Lips

Those that usually suffer from cold sores are more likely to have a break out after a lip procedure, this is due to the fact the virus lays dormant in your body and any trauma could increase the chance of a cold sore developing. This does not mean you cannot have a lip procedure, this just means you need to take extra precautions. Its advised that you use a cream such as Zovirax for 5 days prior to and after the treatment, additionally you can speak to your GP and they may decide to prescribe you some tablets which can also prevent a break out. should you have any questions or queries in regard to your permanent makeup procedure please do not hesitate to contact Jo for advice.

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
